Brief Career Description	Garry qualified as a Chartered Accountant in 1974. He joined BELCO at beginning of 1985 and during first eight years had responsibility for Finance & Administration, Purchasing and Materials, Information Systems, Customer Services. In 1994 Garry became President & CEO of BELCO and during the next fourteen years led BELCO in generating, transmitting and distributing electricity to the island, purchased Bermuda Gas & Utility, developed BELCO Energy Service Company and formed BELCO Holdings Limited to maximize shareholder value through investment in energy.
